We currently have only one public Mass per week on Sunday morning at 10.00am. As congregation numbers increase and as government restrictions allow we will look to reinstate weekday masses.

We are currently unable to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation in Church. If you would like Fr to hear your confession then please approach him as he would be happy to do this after Mass one Sunday or in an outdoor space.

Fr will shortly be resuming Baptismal preparation classes for those parents wishing to have their child baptised. These classes will run for 3 consecutive weeks after Sunday morning Mass. Whilst the same restrictions on numbers of people in our Church at one time apply, it is now possible for Baptisms, Weddings and Funerals to be conducted in Church.

We are pleased to announce that our Church Hall has been rented on a full time basis by Upcycle. Many of you may be familiar with this charity who have relocated from their previous premises to be in the centre of the Castle Vale community whom they serve. Upcycle will open their doors this week. Please pop in and see what they have to offer. Not only is the rental income important for our parish sustainability, we hope to be able to work closely with Upcycle extending the services that we can offer to the residents of Castle Vale. We have excluded the old bar area from the rental agreement as once renovated this will be used as our Parish area. We hope to transform this area into a Café style room for our social gatherings, afternoon teas and maybe open it to the public as a Café a couple of mornings a week. We are currently exploring various avenues for funding in order to make this happen and ask that you keep our intentions, and the needs of our community in your prayers.

CHURCH RE-OPENS

- ◆ No one is obliged come to Mass. There is no obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days. Instead of attending Mass on Sunday you are encouraged to attend on other available days, or to watch live streamed Masses.
- ◆ Some people MUST NOT come to Mass. If you are shielded, self isolating, ill, have symptoms of Covid 19 or are generally infirm and maybe over 70, you should stay at home.
- ◆ The maximum number who can be accommodated in our Church at any one time is 55.
- ◆ Face coverings must be worn, covering both nose and mouth. Please bring your own if possible.
- ◆ Hand gel will be provided and should be used on entering and leaving the church.
- ◆ Please observe the one way system in place and take a seat as directed by the stewards. You must remain in your seat for the duration of Mass. Small children must remain with parents during Mass.
- ◆ In case of a medical emergency please remain in your seat and make a steward aware.
- ◆ In any other emergency again please stay seated and follow the stewards instructions.
- ◆ During Mass there may be some music, provided by Nancy and her family or recorded music, but there should be no congregational singing.
- ◆ At the sign of the peace, there will be no handshake or other physical contact.
- ◆ There will be no offertory procession during the Mass. There will be collection baskets at the exit point.
- ◆ Fr will bring communion to you in your seat. Please remain seated and outstretch your arm to increase the distance between yourself and Fr. If you require a blessing, please indicate this in the usual way with your right arm across your chest.
- ◆ After the final blessing please leave the Church immediately. There will be an opportunity to light votive candles on the way out of church.
- ◆ Feel free - if the weather permits - to engage in socially distanced chatting outside the Church building or in the car park, maintaining social distancing.

Lord, I thank you for this new day. I know that you love me, You look at me at this moment and want this day to be a brand-new beginning with "a future full of hope". Whatever I have to face today, one thing I know is that you will be there with me as my best friend, helping, consoling, strengthening, healing and guiding me.
